Il Monte Castelmarardo raggiunge la quota di 1817 m e da esso prende origine verso nord la Valle Tre Santi; fino a 1600 m circa sono sviluppati boschi di faggio, molto estesi e ben conservati; sopra il limite del bosco i pascoli occupano vaste superfici, con diverse associazioni a seconda delle caratteristiche ambientali. Sulla parte sommitale del Castelmarardo va segnalata, infine, la presenza di molte specie endemiche e poco diffuse.
