Il Pian Perduto è costituito da una conca di origine strutturale e carsica con fondo pianeggiante (m 1329), situata alla base delle pendici orientali del Monte Albuzzago (Monti Sibillini); la vegetazione è esclusivamente erbacea ed è formata da prati umidi e palustri (nardeti e cariceti). Il 20% della vegetazione palustre appartiene all'associazione Caricion gracilis.

4.2 Quality and importance

Piano carsico di eccezionale interesse ambientale e vegetazionale ove hanno trovato rifugio specie erbacee legate agli ambienti palustri, alcune delle quali molto rare in tutto l'Appennino centrale.
