Other Site Characteristics

Valle di origine fluviale scavata dal Fiume Fiastrone nei calcari massicci al limite settentrionale del Gruppo dei M. Sibillini, profonda e incassata fra pareti rocciose che nei punti più stretti distano soltanto pochi metri; sui due versanti si trovano ghiaioni, detriti e conoidi variamente conformati a seconda dell'andamento degli strati e degli effetti erosivi sia fluviali che carsici. Sono presenti anche alcuni depositi di rocce travertinose di origine biogena, in corrispondenza di stillicidi. La vegetazione è formata da boschi di leccio nelle stazioni termicamente favorite e quindi orno-ostrieti e faggete.Orno-Ostryetum : 15%

Imponente vallata appenninica calcarea di aspetto selvaggio, con vasti boschi, che formano una copertura densa e continua. Stato di conservazione ottimo.
