Strette e profonde valli della fascia costiera e dell'immediato entroterra, che dal livello del mare raggiungono la quota di 460 m; il substrato geologico è formato da dune fossili e conglomerati; nelle vallecole si rinvencono boschi residuali con prevalenza di leccio, intercalati da macchie, garrighe e steppe mediterranee.
