Other Site Characteristics

Valle del settore centrale del Gruppo dei Monti Sibillini, delimitata a Nord dal Monte Priora (m 2332) e a Sud dal Monte Sibilla (m 2175); il fondovalle è incassato fra pareti rocciose ripide e strapiombanti. La vegetazione è rappresentata da faggete, fra le quali la fustaia di S. Leonardo, e da pascoli primari, sviluppati al di sopra del limite del bosco, con diverse associazioni che ospitano le tipiche specie endemiche delle montagne calcaree dell'Appennino centrale.

4.2 Quality and importance

Imponente vallata appenninica, che racchiude molteplici aspetti ambientali e vegetazionali di grandissimo valore per la loro unicità; stato di conservazione ottimo. Area di rilevante importanza per la presenza dell'AQUILA REALE e del LUPO. Sito di riproduzione di numerosi rapaci quali ASTORE e GHEPPIO. Presenza di altri mammiferi predatori come GATTO SELVATICO e MARTORA.
